



Article transformation

monosyllabic forms

inn, in, it, ins

dissyllabic forms

innar, ina, inum, inni, inu, inir, inar, inna, inum

single-*n* dissyllables

inir, inar, ina (apm), *ina* (asf), *inum, inu*

[noun ending] + [article] to drop <i>i</i> :	examples:
[short vowel] + [monosyllable]	boginn, bogans, konan, hjartat
[any vowel] + [dissyllable]	ánni, snænum, konunnar
[consonant] + [single- <i>n</i> dissyllable] (except <i>asf</i>)	víkingarnir, þarfarnar, foetrna
dp: noun drops <i>-m</i> , article drops <i>i</i>	børnum + inum > börnunum

[noun ending] + [article] to retain <i>i</i> :	examples
[long vowel] + [monosyllable]	áin, páins, hræit
[consonant] + [monosyllable]	víkingrinn, þorfin, barnsins
[consonant] + <i>ina</i> (asf)	laugina, þorфина, bókina
[consonant] + [double- <i>n</i> dissyllable]	lauginnar, bókinni
