



# Article transformation

**monosyllabic forms**

*inn, in, it, ins*

**dissyllabic forms**

*innar, ina, inum, inni, inu, inir, inar,  
inna, inum*

**single-*n* dissyllables**

*inir, inar, ina (apm), ina (ASF), inum, inu*

[noun ending] + [article] to drop *i*:

examples:

[short vowel] + [monosyllable]

boginn, bogans, konan, hjartat

[any vowel] + [dissyllable]

ánni, snænum, konunnar

[consonant] + [single-*n* dissyllable]  
(except *ASF*)

víkingarnir, þarfarnar, foetrna

dp: noun drops *-m*, article drops *i*

børnum + inum > børnunum

[noun ending] + [article] to retain *i*:

examples

[long vowel] + [monosyllable]

áiñ, páins, hræit

[consonant] + [monosyllable]

víkingrinn, þorfin, barnsins

[consonant] + *ina* (ASF)

laugina, þorfin, bókina

[consonant] + [double-*n* dissyllable]

lauginnar, bókinni
