| <u>β</u> | AM 162a, fol. | 1350 | Wormianus scribe; 1 leaf |
| <u>ε</u> | AM 162a, fol. | 1400 | 3 leaves |
| <u>κ</u> | AM 162a, fol. | 1400 | 2 leaves |
| <u>ι</u> | AM 162a, fol. | 15th c. | 1 leaf |
| <u>η</u> | AM 162a, fol. | 1450–1475 | 2 leaves |
| <u>α</u> | AM 162a, fol. | 16th c. | paper, 3 leaves |
| <u>K</u> | AM 453, 4 ^{to} | 17th c. | <u>Ketilsbók</u> : paper; an identical copy exists in AM 462, 4 ^{to} ; copied from ε; most modernized text; the only complete witness |
